

# What is child sexual exploitation?



People under 18 encouraged or forced into a sexual relationship or situation by an adult. It involves young people being offered something, such as alcohol, cigarettes, mobile phones, money, drugs or 'love', in return for performing sexual acts.

Child sexual exploitation (CSE) can happen to any child. It happens to boys and girls from all communities across the 11-18 age range and sometimes to even younger children.
