

Safer Recruitment Briefing

To ensure that safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is an integral part of recruitment processes and HR management for organisations that work with children.

- understand the key features of staff recruitment that help deter or prevent the appointment of unsuitable people
- be aware of policies and practices that minimise opportunities for abuse or ensure its prompt reporting
- Be able to review their own and their organisations' policies and practices in recruitment with a view to making them safer
