

Child Sexual Exploitation – a Resilience Approach for Families

A ONE DAY MULTI-AGENCY COURSE

Why is this course for you?

This course will be of use to staff/professionals from a variety of agencies and services who work with young people and/or their families who may be at risk of child sexual exploitation.

Our team of frontline specialist child sexual exploitation family support practitioners have developed this course to share their experiences, evidence based practice techniques and resources used which have been developed over years of working with survivors of child sexual exploitation.

This participatory training uses real life experiences to enable an understanding of child sexual exploitation, its impact on families, and explains young people's responses to CSE. It will change the way you think and consequently the way you support children and families facing CSE.

After attending the training there will be further opportunities for support and advice via invitations to Placement Support Service case consultation and peer support meetings. Further information will be provided after the course for those interested.

Course pre-requisite

You **must have** completed 'Safeguarding Children from Abuse by Sexual Exploitation' e-learning or recent face to face basic training in the subject area to apply for this course.

- The impact of child sexual exploitation on whole families
- Working with those identified at high risk or experiencing CSE
- Grooming models
- Vulnerabilities and resilience
- Attachment and Trauma bonds
- Resources and evidence based practice models
- Develop a unique action plan for working with children and families facing child sexual exploitation
- Tips and feedback to workers
