

Allegations Management Briefing

A half day multi-agency course

Target Audience

This course is for **managers** of staff who have contact with children including **heads of service**, **head teachers**, **human resource managers** and **managers** in all BSCB partner agencies.

Course aim

To ensure that all organisations that provide services to children, or provide staff or volunteers to work with or care for children, operate a procedure for handling allegations against staff that are consistent with the following:

Working Together to Safeguard Children 2018

BSCB Allegations against Staff, Carers and Volunteers

Section 11 Children's Act 2004 and Section 175 Education Act 2002; places duties on organisations and individuals to safeguard and promote the welfare of children

- Be aware of the national guidance and the BSCB procedures
- Understand the thresholds for applying the procedure
- Understand their role and responsibility in ensuring that their organisation follows the procedures
- Understand the role of the Designated Officer (DO)
